The Gospel (Good News) of Jesus the Christ

John 3:16 For God so loved the world (you) that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in Him shall not perish but have everlasting life.

In Christ alone, our sin, guilt and shame are completely forgiven.

Believe in your heart that Jesus Christ is the Son of God, and confess Jesus, by name, as the one who made atonement for your sin, and he will cleanse you from all of your unrighteousness. The down payment of your eternal life in Christ is the Holy Spirit, who will come into your heart and make you a brand-new creation.

In the final judgement, at the name of Jesus, every knee shall bow and every tongue shall confess that Jesus Christ is the LORD, to the glory of God the Father. If we trust in Jesus now, and receive him as Lord in this life, there is no more condemnation of sin (Romans 8:1-2, 33-34).

Not by works of righteousness that we have done, but according to His mercy he saved us.

All our righteousness are as filthy rags, instead, depend on the righteousness of Jesus the Christ alone.

Confess your faith in Jesus Christ and receive the Holy Spirit.
