

## **The Gospel (Good News) of Jesus the Christ**

**John 3:16** For God so loved the world (**you**) that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in Him shall not perish but have everlasting life.

Because of our own sin, every living person has been separated from the loving God that created them. God's word is truth and because of his righteousness no sinful creature can live in his presence. Sin only corrupts and destroys, so in his mercy, God does not allow mankind to live forever in their sin, for the wages of sin is death.

**How shall we escape if we neglect so great a salvation?**

**Romans 10:9-10** If you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus, and believe in your heart, that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. For with the heart man believes unto righteousness and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.

**In Christ alone, our sin, guilt and shame are completely forgiven.**

Believe in your heart that Jesus Christ is the Son of God, and confess Jesus, by name, as the one who made atonement for your sin, and he will cleanse you from all of your unrighteousness. The down payment of your eternal life in Christ is the Holy Spirit, who will come into your heart and make you a brand-new creation.

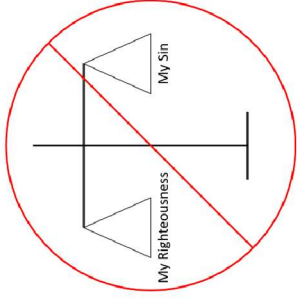
In the final judgement, at the name of Jesus, every knee shall bow and every tongue shall confess that Jesus Christ is the LORD, to the glory of God the Father. If we trust in Jesus now, and receive him as Lord in this life, there is no more condemnation of sin (Romans 8:1-2, 33-34).

If you are convinced of your sin, the righteousness of Jesus the Christ, and that he took the judgement of your sin upon himself at the cross, then **REPENT!**

**Not by works of righteousness that we have done, but according to His mercy he saved us.**

All our righteousness are as filthy rags, instead, depend on the righteousness of Jesus the Christ alone.

**Confess your faith in Jesus Christ and receive the Holy Spirit.**

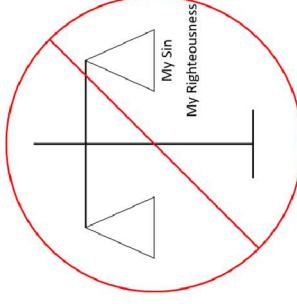


### Many people think

But the Bible doesn't teach that.

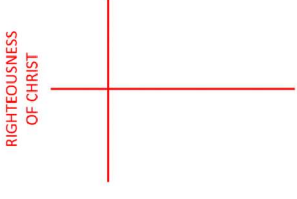
That is not found anywhere in scripture.

Whosoever believeth on him shall not be ashamed. For there is no difference between the Jew and the Greek: for the same Lord over all  
is rich unto all that call upon him. For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved. (Romans 10:9-13)
